**Location:**

The Redwood Village Pool is located at 3597 Cherilyn Ct. off Young Ave in Northwest Napa. The phone number for the pool house is (707) 252-9962 it's mailing address is PO Box 3623 Napa, CA 94558

**Memberships and Membership Area (per our By Laws):**

*\*Regular Members:* Those are members who reside within the boundaries of Redwood Road, Linda Vista, Trower and Dry Creek but does not include homes on the roads listed above (some homes on Linda Vista may qualify). Other areas included for Regular members are Dickerson Lane, Crystal Ct and Lap Ct as per our By-Laws.

*\*Sponsored Members:* Those are members who have been sponsored by a current regular member and live outside the boundaries listed above. The Sponsored Membership is held on a year-by-year basis only (January 1 through December 31 of each year per Article XVI) although accepted sponsored members do not need to reapply every year and will be renewed as long as their dues are paid on time. When an opening occurs regular members that have submitted an application will be called first, then sponsored members in order of application date.

**Applicants for RVSC Membership:**

If you know of someone you would like to join and or know of someone who has expressed their desire to join, they will need to fill out an application for membership and mail it to our P.O. Box. This does not guarantee their membership since we typically have awaiting list. When a spot opens Resident members have priority and, then Sponsored applicants from

the waiting list . The sooner applications are filled out, the greater the chance of joining for next year as the waiting list is ranked by postmark of applications. NOTE – Applications must be mailed as they will not be accepted if given to any Staff or Board Member. \*Senior Memberships are only available for regular members, If you are a regular member and you or your spouse is over 55 you can apply for senior membership by sending in the senior membership status application to the RVSC P.O. Box

### **Cancellation/ Membership lapse:**

Regular Members Only Membership Lapse: Each year you may want to consider whether you want to let your membership lapse. Regular Memberships that have lapsed will be charged a reinstatement fee of \$100 and will only be reinstated if there is a slot available.

Sponsored Memberships that lapse or are cancelled will have to be reapplied for. A Notice of Cancellation form is available on the web site for down load and should be sent to the Board Via the P.O. Box.

### **Guest Policy /Fees**

A member must accompany Guest(s) at all times. Members are responsible for their guests.

There is a Six (6) guests per day limit. Members who wish to bring more than six guests must call on the duty lifeguard at the pool prior to arrival for approval. Members must accept lifeguard's decision.

Members bringing guests must be at least 13 years old.

**Guest Fees are for Pool Area Use Only Not for BBQ use**

Guest Fee is \$3.00 per person

There are 10 Punch Guest Passes available for \$20 for reduced rate guest fees

Please be considerate of your other Members if your having guests to bbq at the pool the 6 person guest limit does apply to the bbq area as well as to the pool area

Who can I bring as a guest?

Senior Regular Members:

May bring their Children and their Grand Children Free all Siblings, Cousins, Nieces, Nephews and friends must pay a guest fee

Regular Members, Sponsored Members and Renters:

May bring their Parents, and their Children Free all Siblings, Cousins, Nieces, Nephews and friends must pay a guest fee

Babysitters accompanying a members children in lieu of the member do not pay a guest fee

**Reserving Pool or Table(s) for Birthdays, Family Reunions, Parties, and Special Events:**

Contact the RVSC Manager at 252-9962 or e mail them from the web site to schedule any events.

Scheduling depends greatly on availability of pool and lifeguards.

During normal pool hours, the first priority is to accommodate the members. Example: On special member events like the 4<sup>th</sup> of July and the end of year Luau, the pool and or available staff may not be able to accommodate the number of people at the pool and thus even small parties or guests on these days may not be available.

Reservations will depend on availability of the pool schedule and staffing.

Regular Pool Hour Parties up to 40 Guests

MAX , Parties are for 2 hours max

20 to 30 guests \$100

### **Swimmer vs. Non-Swimmer:**

- Children will be tested by the lifeguard to determine swimming ability
- All non-swimmers must be with an adult and are NEVER ALLOWED ON THE DIVING BOARD!

### **Flotation Device:**

- Only Coast Guard Approved Life Jackets are allowed in pool.
- No other floating devices are allowed in the pool.

### **Pool Safety:**

For the health and welfare of all who use the pool, the lifeguards will record names of children whose behavior has created a problem at the pool on the daily attendance sheets. The parents of any child whose name appears more than four times will be contacted by the board. Everyone needs to do their best to maintain a safe and happy pool environment.

### **Pool Cover:**

If you are at the pool near closing time, please volunteer to help put the pool cover on. Total time is less than 5-10 minutes.

***Remember, this is still just a community pool .... if we do not get your help for little things like helping with the pool cover at the close of the night, picking up loose trash, minor maintenance work etc, we will have no choice but to keep on increasing the DUES! Please pitch in where you can ... Example, if you see a gate latch that is not working, please feel free to just fix it and send us the bill for the hardware. Umbrella's, if a screw, rope or something needs fixing or replacing ... as NIKE would say "just do it" and fix the item.***
